Minimum Requirements:

- 500 meter swim (22 laps) in 10 minutes or less
- Successful completion/ passing of the following:
 - A) Medical Exam (eyesight correctable to 20/40)
 - B) Drug Test
 - C) Background Check if 18 years and older
- Applicants must be 16 years of age by June 21, 2012

Swim Release Form with a parents' signature required from all applicants under 18 years old before participation in the swim test. Download the Swim Release form at:

Process for Consideration:

- 1) Handwritten Application: Available day of the tryouts (arrive early to fill-out).
- 2) Swim Test/ interview:
 - Sunday, March 11, 8:00 AM** at the YMCA, 27341 Trabuco Circle, Mission Viejo, CA
 - Saturday, March 17, 8:00 AM** at Lake Mission Viejo, 22555 Olympiad Rd., Mission Viejo, CA
- 3) Oral Interview: Applicants who complete the swim test within the minimum requirement will be given an individual time for an interview, between 9:00AM and 5:00PM (same day).

Upon Acceptance:

- Successful applicants must participate in a mandatory (USLA) 96- hour open water lifeguard training program, consisting of 5 consecutive weekend dates, Saturday and Sunday.
- Information/ welcome night (parents welcome): **Thursday evening, March 24, 7:00-8:30 PM**
- Mandatory Training Dates:** March 31, & April 1, 7, 8, 14, 15, 21, 22, 28, & 29, from 8:00 AM to 5:00PM

Disclaimer: ANY ABSENCE of one of the above dates due to; vacation, injury, sporting events, etc., will RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE PROCESS. If you are planning on being absent any of the above dates do not start the training program – absolutely no exceptions will be made.
